## What do you want to hear from Toronto's Municipal Candidates?

COTAPSA intends to survey every candidate in the upcoming Toronto municipal election seeking their views on issues that impact our members.

But first we want to hear what you want to hear from the candidates so we can include them in our survey.

Our goals are as follows:

- To identify those candidates who support COTAPSA and are interested in engaging non-union employees in a positive and meaningful way
- To identify candidate's opinions on issues important to our members
- To educate candidates on the important work COTAPSA members perform for the City on a daily basis and how they would support the work we do.

We intend to focus our questions in the following areas so please provide us with the questions you want answers to under the following discussion areas:

- Consulting and engaging with COTAPSA in major City decisions
- Compensation and benefits provided to the City's non-union employees;
- Important issues that candidates foresee which may impact non-unionized employees
- The right of City-funded agencies (e.g. TCHC, Exhibition Place, Toronto Zoo) to be represented by COTAPSA

Our plan is to deploy the Toronto Municipal Candidate Survey via *Survey Planet* during the summer, collect responses by the end of August and post the results with candidate names on the COTAPSA website after Labour Day.
