CIMA Mayor's Trophy (CMT) Cricket Celebration

COTAPSA is pleased to invite Members to the annual CIMA Mayor's Trophy (CMT) Cricket celebration, taking place on June 22, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. in Sunnybrook Park, 1132 Leslie St.

CMT is an annual Toronto community event, launched in 2005 by former Toronto Mayor David Miller and Former Toronto Police Chief Bill Blair. This collaborative initiative, celebrating its 20th anniversary this year, is a partnership project between Toronto Parks, Forestry & Recreation and CIMA Canada, a membership association of internationally qualified accountants.

Endorsed by Toronto City Council, CMT is more than just a cricket tournament; it is a community celebration that brings Toronto's diverse communities together through the globally popular sport of cricket. The event has received recognition from the International Cricket Council for its outstanding engagement with communities through cricket.

This year's celebration will feature participation from various public sector cricket teams, including Toronto Police, Toronto Housing, TTC, Metrolinx, as well as media teams such as Globe and Mail, CBC, and Rogers. Representing the City of Toronto will be two employee cricket teams from Toronto Water and a third team from Engineering Construction Services (ECS). Mayor Olivia Chow, City Councillors, and public sector leaders will take part in a ceremonial cricket match to officially open the event.
